

CARS Net – Net Control Station Script Outline

Check to see that the repeater is not in use (by listening for *several* minutes or check by calling on the repeater). If in use, try to ask the stations to allow the net to operate.

Repeater check text:

CQ, CQ, _____ (call sign), checking the frequency.

(If nothing heard): Stand by for the CARS club net, beginning in ____ minutes.

CARS Net - Net Control Script

CQ, CQ, CQ - Good evening. It's time for the Capital Amateur Radio Society (CARS) Net. This Net meets each Monday night at 8:30 P. M. local time on the 147.105 repeater in Frankfort, Kentucky. Our repeater has a PL tone of 107.2. This is an informal net and can be used to pass emergency and non-emergency traffic and to make comments and announcements. All amateur stations are invited to check in to the net. Net Control for tonight's session is _____ (call sign) and the name of net control is _____ (name).

First of all is there any emergency or priority traffic to be listed at this time? If so, please call _____ (call sign). (Pause at least 30 seconds, list in log)

All participating stations are reminded that should they have emergency or priority traffic that needs to be listed during the net, they should call for a break by calling Emergency or Break, Break. Priority will be given to all stations needing to list emergency or priority traffic.

Do we have anyone tonight checking in on mobiles or on short time? If so, please call _____ (call sign). (Pause at least 30 seconds, list in log)

We will now begin accepting routine check-ins. Please check in with your call sign, first name and your city or county of operation. At the completion of check ins, we will return to the top of the list to take comments and announcements, so please stick around once you have checked in with net control. Check-ins, please call _____ (call sign). (Pause at least 30 seconds, list in log) (NOTE: If no check-ins, skip the next two paragraphs.)

Okay, now let's go back to the top of the list and check back with our check-ins for this evening. Stations wishing to make comments or announcements may do so as we check back with you. (Run through list of check-ins, noting any announcements)

Well that takes us back to the bottom of the list.

This is the CARS Net in Frankfort, Kentucky. Our repeater has a PL tone of 107.2 for stations that have found us for the first time and would like to check in with us. Are there any stations wishing to check-in? If so, please call _____ (call sign). (You may repeat this paragraph multiple times if needed or necessary. Run through the list of check-ins after they check in.)

Are there any stations that want to make any additional comments or announcements? If so, please call _____ (call sign).

At this time we'll issue one final request for any station wishing a late check in. Any station wishing to check in please call _____ (call sign).

We would like to thank each and every station for checking in tonight and ask you to encourage other stations to join us on Monday nights at 8:30 P.M. local time for the CARS Net. We would also like to thank K4TG for allowing us the use of the repeater for this Net. This session of the CARS Net is closed at ____:____ (time) and the repeater is now returned to General Amateur service. Good Evening and 73, _____ (call sign)
